ACN is a Papal Foundation that supports 6,000 communities in 140 countries.

An important part of the work of ACN is to highlight those often-forgotten Christian communities who are persecuted or discriminated against because of their faith in Christ. **Today, 360 million Christians live under active persecution.**

Next week we will send you material in the post about ACN's annual **'Week of Witness'** campaign which takes place every November, and at the heart of which is **'Red Wednesday'** when we seek to raise awareness and prayerful solidarity. This year, the Week of Witness runs from November 17-24 with Red Wednesday falling on November 20.
